

Love! Card UK



I love mixing up my different crafty hobbies; this one's card making and crochet.

Pattern:

You will need some stash yarn and a matching hook; I used dk and a size 4.00mm hook. Don't use anything too chunky unless you are making a giant card!

Tip: when making the letters, try crocheting the dc's into the back ridge of the chain so that the two loops remain unworked. This makes the edging the same all the way around.

To make the L:

Ch 13, dc in 2nd ch from hook, dc in next 6 ch, (3dc) in next ch, dc in last 4 dc. Fasten off.

To make the heart:

Start by making a magic ring and chaining 1.

Round 1: 3tr, 1htr, 2dc, 1tr, 2dc, htr, 3 tr into ring. Chain 1 and sl-st into ring, pull to close.

Round 2: ch1, dc into chain space before the first tr of the last round. 2htr in each of the next 3 sts, 3htr, (htr, tr) in next st, (tr, htr) in next st, 3htr, 2htr in next 3 sts, sl-st into chain space, finish with an invisible join into the 1st dc.

Fasten off.

To make the v:

Ch 16, starting in 2nd ch from hook dc in each of next 7 chs, (5dc) in next ch, dc in each of last 7 chs, fasten off.

To make the e:

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Ch 22, sk 14 sts, sl st into next ch making sure the chain is not twisted. Turn and work 1dc into each st around, fasten off.

To make the !:

For the line, ch 8, starting in 2nd ch from hook, dc in each of 7 chs, fasten off.

For the dot, make a magic ring and dc 6 times into it, pull to close. Join with an invisible join, or a sl-st if you prefer. Fasten off.

Weave in all the ends. The letters can look a little wonky or twisty, but don't worry about blocking, they can be fixed into place with glue or stitching.
